

Anatoliy Kryvolap: Master of Vibrating Color

The next in the series of art exhibitions to be organized by ARTEast in conjunction with the American Chamber of Commerce will open December 7 at the AmCham offices. The exhibition titled "Composition" features the vivid and creative mastery of one of the most prominent Ukrainian artists, Anatoliy Kryvolap, and will run till February, 2003. Anatoliy Kryvolap and his tender and yet inexorable paintings have already been high-

ly praised by the AmCham Members at the exhibition titled "Mystery of Colors" and held at the AmCham offices in the beginning of summer 2001.
